Proclamation




- WHEREAS:** bicycling is an important component of Fayetteville's present and future transportation system for all residents and visitors, and
- WHEREAS:** bicycling has been recognized worldwide as an affordable, non-polluting method of transport that relieves traffic congestion, promotes livable community design and preserves environmental quality, and
- WHEREAS:** bicycling has direct positive effects on the health and well-being of individuals and communities in which they live, and
- WHEREAS:** the City of Fayetteville has been nationally recognized as a Bicycle Friendly Community by the League of American Bicyclists since 2010, and
- WHEREAS:** the League of American Bicyclists has established the month of May as National Bike Month to increase public awareness of bicycling and encourage more people to begin bicycling, and
- WHEREAS:** this day, Friday, May 19th has been established as National Bike to Work Day to celebrate biking as a healthy, fun, and green way to commute, and
- WHEREAS:** Fayetteville's outstanding trails and bikeways provide pleasant places for biking throughout our community and the Razorback Regional Greenway now connects to our trails to neighboring cities.

"Bike Month"


in Fayetteville, Arkansas and urge all citizens to observe this month by breaking out your bicycles, strapping on your helmets, and participating in Bike Month events.
