WHEREAS: if left untreated, Pulmonary Hypertension is often fatal. Although it can affect persons of all ages and backgrounds, it predominately strikes women between the ages of 20 and 40, and

WHEREAS: early detection is very important in the treatment of Pulmonary Hypertension. The best way to detect Pulmonary Hypertension is to request an echocardiogram, and


WHEREAS: research has come a long way in the last ten years and continues to progress.

"PULMONARY HYPERTENSION AWARENESS MONTH"


