## **Junior Counselor Program**

The Junior Counselor (JC) program is for high school students who have completed at least one year of high school. The goal of the JC program is to provide leadership and job- related training and experience.



Please read the following information carefully.

The application deadline is May 1, 2018. All parts of the application including one reference letter from a non-family member is due by this date. Applications can be submitted in person or by mail to the Yvonne Richardson Community Center (240 E Rock St; Fayetteville, AR) or by email to <a href="mailto:slivengood@fayetteville-ar.gov">slivengood@fayetteville-ar.gov</a>. Applications submitted after deadline will only be considered if positions are still available. We hope to complete placements by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

REFERENCE LETTER: If reference is sent via <u>email</u> it must be from a school or business-related email account. References from gmail, yahoo, hotmail, etc. will not be accepted. Hand written reference letters must be in a sealed envelope with reference's signature across envelope's seal.

INTERVIEWS: The YRCC Program Coordinator and/or Director will conduct interviews, if necessary, to determine if applicant is a good fit for the Junior Counselor program.

ORIENTATION: All students placed in program will be required to attend orientation as part of their leadership training. Orientation will be May 31- June 1 from 10am-3pm each day. Lunch and snack will be provided. <u>Junior Counselors who have attended training the year before will only be required to come to training on June 1.</u>

Placement in program is based on professionalism and enthusiasm, and at the discretion of YRCC staff. Junior Counselors are not required to be at camp for all seven sessions, unless they so desire. However, we expect a commitment to the weeks they have chosen to participate in the JC program barring any illness or emergency.
